

1969 Dodge Charger 500

Only 392 Charger 500s were made in 1969 – of those only 27 were Hemi-4 speed cars

Evidently the guy never repaired the engine or the kid got disgusted or who knows. Any rate the car sat outside near the kid's house for years untouched. The paint cracked from the sun and weather and the interior suffered from the heat and cold. Never the less the car survived well. The exhaust and everything beneath the car is nice. It was a factory four speed car with a 4:10 Dana. However I do not especially care for the Dana so I changed to an 8 ¾ with plenty of gear options. I purchased the car to build for myself and have moved accordingly until I located an ultra-nice GTX that I prefer. I have spent \$500 having the paint stripped and the car repainted the original color. It turned out beautiful as you will see in subsequent pictures. I have already had an engine built by Roger Green and it is ready to be installed. If I don't sell it as is, I will go ahead with my plans to complete the car." Texas car, stored since '74. Purchased by Mike '79 and stored inside since that time.
